Treasurer's Report:

General Fund \$14,963.78 Trail Fund \$1,074.46 Junior Fund \$454.38

New Business: Approval of funds for Napa Valley Fire Victims. Ten organizations were suggested & details provided to those present.

Lori motioned that the club give \$1500 each to two different organizations. Jeanine seconded the motion. Elisabet abstained; all else in favor. Motion passed.

After discussion regarding all possibilities, two motions were made:

Jeanine motioned that one organization be the Sonoma Horse Council - Equine Disaster. This is an organization currently aiding in relief efforts. All in favor, motion passed.

Jeanine motioned that the second organization be the UC Davis Catastrophic Need Fund. Barbara abstained; all else in favor. Motion passed.

Ride Report: 2017 Quicksilver Fall Classic resulted in approximately \$5,000 profit. However, there was substantial labor cost. It was difficult to get enough volunteers ahead of time. 50% of volunteers were non-club members. We need volunteer signups in advance to take pressure off the ride management team. Next year, encourage volunteer signups via ride entry form, Quips, and website in addition to email requests.

Awards Banquet: Will be on <u>February 3, 2018</u> at the Westside Grill in Gilroy, organized by Mary Anderson once again. Save the date and RSVP to Mary, please!

Motion by Jill: That Lori & Jayne put together a yearbook in lieu of a calendar this year. Melissa seconded the motion. All were in favor; motion passed.

Jeanine will ask last year's award winners to form a committee (winner as the chair + two more) and ask the club for nominations for this year's awards.

Ballots will be sent out for nominations of new board members, as several current board members are rotating out.


